Anusha is very passionate about her work in STEM and is one of the first people to create a meditation program to be used in clinical breast cancer research at Hoag Hospital.

Anusha is also an Adjunct Professor and Inclusive Excellence Faculty Fellow at San Diego State University, where she teaches on the intersection of wellness, politics, and social justice. Anusha is the recipient of the 2024 Darlene Shiley Honors Faculty Fellowship Award which recognizes her outstanding teaching at the Weber Honors College at SDSU.

Anusha is an official SXSW 2024 and 2025 speaker and sought-after motivational speaker around the world on the science of mindfulness and meditation and the intersection of wellness and social justice. Intersectionality and addressing health and gender inequities is at the heart of all that Anusha is involved with.
