DESCRIPTION

The practice of noninvasive vascular technology is a challenging and changing environment. The latest techniques are presented with feedback given by audience members. Case studies, research results and new techniques are described in detail.

OBJECTIVES

- 1 Describe new techniques in noninvasive vascular technology.
- 1 Discuss the newest methods of vascular testing and evaluate their potential pitfalls and benefits.
- 1 Describe the progression of consecutive venous flow in the legs, highlighting the transition from continuous to phasic flow in the absence of underlying pathology, and discussing sonographic assessment and clinical significance.
- 2 Analyze the vascular ultrasound findings of a focal common carotid artery dissection with associated carotid artery ulceration, highlighting key imaging characteristics and diagnostic considerations.
- 2 Establish strategies to build collaborative relationships with vascular technologists to improve patient care and communication.
- 2 Evaluate new methods of evaluation in vascular disease testing.
- 3 Explain the sonographic findings and clinical presentation of superior mesenteric artery (SMA) syndrome, emphasizing key imaging features, diagnostic criteria, and implications for patient management.
